Member's status

Every person who is interested in contemporary mosaic can become member of the AIMC: Professional mosaicists, artists, architects, gallerists, art critics, students and amateurs.

Solely the acknowledged *quality of mosaic works* is the real criterion of a person's status within the AIMC.

The professional mosaicists must have made mosaic works in private and public buildings or smaller art works which have been exposed in collective and personal exhibitions or in galleries and museums.

The qualification of those contemporary mosaic works will be given by the unquestionable judgement of the AIMC Board of Directors.

Only these qualified works or images of them can be presented in exhibitions on international level.

For every member it should be a continuous stimulus to reach this high standard.

Other members who merely appreciate and love contemporary mosaics support the AIMC with their contributions.

Student members have the same rights of ordinary ones. They only have to pay the half of the regular annual fee, and they don't pay any entrance fee. They have to give proof of being regularly enrolled in art schools or universities. When their state of students is over and if they wish to be ordinary members they have to pay both the entrance fee and the annual fees.

Honorary members are elected among those people who either through their own activity or on behalf of public or private Bodies, have encouraged or supported an activity particularly interesting and worthy according to the aims of the association. They have the right to vote.

All members (ordinary, students and honorary ones) are forbidden to take personal enterprises of any kind such as exhibitions, publications of books, commercial activities, meeting with Bodies or people *in the name of the AIMC* unless they have in hand a permit approved by the Directory.

Every new member receives the entire Statute of AIMC.
